The IMF programme - International Monetary Fund - was established on 27th December 1945.

The main aims of the IMF programs were to :
 stabilise financial funds; ~~encourage~~ encourage business
 and develop the economy; help the developing countries
 in financial crisis and to ensure that there isn't another
 global issue such as the great depression.

As those are the advantages, many ~~less~~ developing countries
 met the targets of the IMF of conquering financial crisis.
 Few Countries such as Malawi and Ghana have been punish-
 ed with flu epidemics and famines even though they
