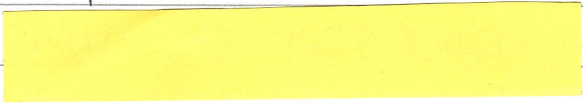

The IMF programme - International Monetary fund - was established on 27th december 1945.

After 29 ~~the~~ representatives signed an agreement, monetary income increased and the fund received huge sums of money.

This ~~the~~ accumulated more participants to become a part of the IMF, ~~meeting~~ ~~the~~ until there were 167 country representatives involved in the development project.

The main aims of the IMF programs were to: stabilise financial funds; ~~keep~~ incorporate businesses and develop the economy; help the developing countries in financial crisis and to ensure that there isn't another global issue such as the great depression.

As those are the advantages, many ~~see~~ developing countries met the targets of the IMF of conquering financial crisis. ~~East~~ Countries such as Malawi and Ghana have been punished with flu epidemics and famines even though they obeyed the ~~obey~~ demands of the IMF.
